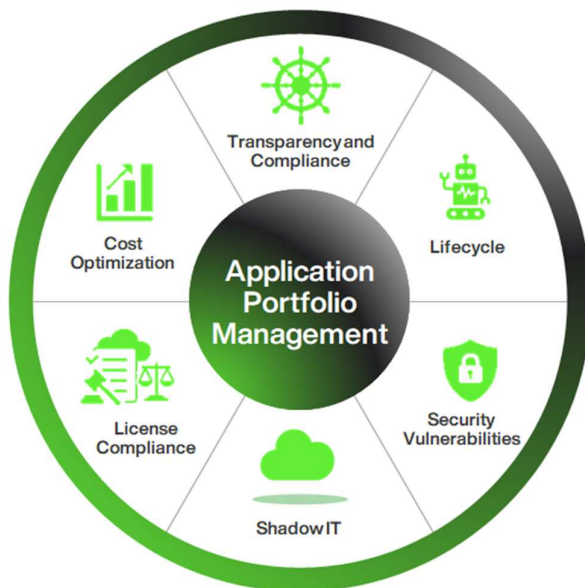




Application Portfolio Management

Initial discussion & requirements clarification

Current-state analysis

Setup phase

Continuous maintenance

An application landscape requires ongoing maintenance. Appropriate processes must be established and responsibilities clearly defined.

When does Application Portfolio Management pay off?

Release freezes

When no one dares to update applications anymore. The application landscape stagnates because dependencies and impacts of updates are unclear.

Increasing maintenance costs

License and maintenance costs continuously rise without visible added value. It is often unclear which licenses are still actively used.

Improving security

Outdated releases contain unresolved security vulnerabilities, putting the entire IT landscape – and the organization – at risk.

Strengthening collaboration with business units
